

Terms and Conditions

Your acceptance of the terms and conditions

Your purchase of the Computershare Tax Information Pack (**Portfolio Tax Information Pack**) online via the Investor Centre website (**Investor Centre**) is subject to the terms and conditions set out below, as well as the notices, disclaimers and other terms and conditions contained on Investor Centre and the Portfolio Tax Information Pack (together, the **terms and conditions**). Any subsequent purchase of a Portfolio Tax Information Pack by you will also be subject to these terms and conditions, as amended from time to time.

Computershare Investor Services Pty Limited (ABN 48 078 279 277) (**Computershare**) may, in its sole discretion amend these terms and conditions at any time. Computershare will notify you of any such changes by publishing the amended terms and conditions online via Investor Centre. Changes will be effective immediately once published.

About the Portfolio Tax Information Pack

The Portfolio Tax Information Pack allows you to electronically purchase, download and view tax, payment and holding balance information of securityholdings where the register of holders is maintained by Computershare and the issuer of those securities has permitted the use of this information in this manner. In addition, the Portfolio Tax Information Pack only allows you to view payment and holding balance information for the portfolio of securityholdings within your Investor Centre account.

Accordingly, based on the above, you may be unable to view payment and holding balance information through the Portfolio Tax Information Pack for all your securityholdings.

Exclusions

Computershare has taken, and will continue to take, reasonable care in preparing your Portfolio Tax Information Pack, but does not guarantee that the information contained therein is accurate or complete. In particular, Computershare is not responsible for the accuracy of information provided by third parties or the accuracy of the closing balance shown for a securityholding. It is your sole responsibility to review the information supplied in your Portfolio Tax Information Pack to ensure it is accurate and complete.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, all conditions, warranties, guarantees, rights, remedies, liabilities and other terms implied or conferred by statute, custom or the general law that impose any liability or obligation on Computershare are excluded under these terms and conditions. If a supply under these terms and conditions is a supply of goods or services to a consumer within the meaning of the Australian Consumer Law, nothing contained in these terms and conditions excludes, restricts or modifies the application of any provision, the exercise of any right or remedy, or the imposition of any liability under the Australian Consumer Law (non-excludable obligations), provided that, to the extent that the Australian Consumer Law permits Computershare to limit its liability, then Computershare's liability is limited to supplying the services again or paying the cost of having the services supplied again.

Security of information

Warranties, confirmations and undertakings

By purchasing your Portfolio Tax Information Pack, you are deemed to have given the following warranties, confirmations and undertakings.

1. When purchasing the Portfolio Tax Information Pack in respect of a securityholding(s), you warrant that you are either the securityholder or that you are duly authorised by the securityholder to purchase and download the Portfolio Tax Information Pack. You indemnify Computershare from all liabilities, losses, damages, costs and expenses (including reasonable legal expenses) which Computershare may suffer or incur by reason of a breach of the above warranty given by you.
2. When you purchase the Portfolio Tax Information Pack in respect of a securityholding(s) that is in joint names, you warrant that you are:
 - one of the named joint holders and that you have obtained the consent of all the other joint holders to act on their behalf in respect of the securityholding(s) in purchasing and downloading the Portfolio Tax Information Pack; or
 - not one of the named joint holders, but you have been authorised by all of the joint holders to act on their behalf in respect of the securityholding in purchasing and downloading the Portfolio Tax Information Pack.

You indemnify Computershare from all liabilities, losses, damages, costs and expenses (including reasonable legal expenses) which Computershare may suffer or incur by reason of a breach of the above warranty given by you.

3. When you purchase the Portfolio Tax Information Pack in respect of a securityholding(s) that is in the name of a company, you warrant that you have been duly authorised by the board of directors of that company to act on its behalf in purchasing and downloading the Portfolio Tax Information Pack and you indemnify Computershare from all liabilities, losses, damages, costs and expenses (including reasonable legal expenses) which Computershare may suffer or incur by reason of a breach of the above warranty given by you.
4. Computershare may suspend or terminate your access to the Portfolio Tax Information Pack at any time without prior notice if Computershare reasonably suspects that you are in breach of these terms. For example, if Computershare suspects you are in breach of the above warranties or that you are using, or have used or permitted anyone to use, the Portfolio Tax Information Pack in an unauthorised manner.

In the event that any part of these terms and conditions is not legally enforceable, the remaining terms and conditions will not be affected and will remain valid and enforceable

These terms and conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Victoria, Australia. You agree that, in the event of a dispute, the courts of Victoria, Australia will have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of that dispute.
